Tips for Banking Online Safely

1. Monitor your accounts regularly. – Make sure all transactions are authorized ones and if not contact the credit union immediately.
2. Look out for strange emails. – Don't respond to emails that claim to be from us requesting personal information. We will not reach out to you in this way.
3. Avoid clicking links in emails. – It is better to login to the credit union website manually to ensure you are entering a secure site.
4. Change your passwords regularly. – Avoid using the same password across multiple sites and make sure you are using a strong password.
5. Enable two-factor authentication. – Some financial institutions have added an extra layer of security that requires an extra verification before account access.
6. Disable automatic login. – Do not allow your web browser to store private username and passwords for your online banking.
7. When available, use the credit union's official mobile app. – Make sure you download apps from reputable sources like the Apple Store or Google Play Store.
